FROM THE MEDITERRANEAN TO THE
CANTABRIAN
From the 6th October to 10th October 2023**

Organized by IPA Catalunya, the 4rd Transpirenaica IPA route is not a race nor a rally. It's a journey through the beautiful French and Spanish Pyrenees, alternating between the two countries during the entire route.

For those who enjoy riding the bike and long tour journeys, it's a hard path, full of winding roads and high mountains, featuring and landscapes that can only be enjoyed when riding a bike in different ways.

This route combines planning, adventure and improvisation, making it a challenge.

The route will last five days, distributed as follows:

1st. Day (Friday 06/10/2023): Reception of participants from 18.00 to 20.00, delivery of material at **Marina hotel, Av. Rhode, 81-83 Roses (Girona)**.

The delivery of material finishes at 20.00h. Please be advised not to exceed this time for reasons related to the organization.

From 20.00h to 20.30h a briefing and recommendations will be made at the hotel regarding the route.

At 9:00 p.m. Farewell dinner.

2nd Day: (Saturday 07/10/2023): Roses-Andorra. Departure of participants from 08.30 h. Arrival at Andorra from 17,00H. Check in hotel **Yomo Patagonia, Carretera de Comallemple s/n, AD400 Arinsal, (ANDORRA)**. **Parking inside the hotel**.

At 9:00 p.m. Farewell dinner

3rd. Day: (Sunday 08/10/2023): Departure from Andorra at 08.30h. Arrival at Jaca after viewing Puerto de Cotefablo and Añisclo Canyon. From 18.00 h check-in at **the Hotel Oroel Av de Francia, 37 (JACA)**. **Parking inside hotel**.

RULES OF THE ROAD

Due to the current circumstances caused by Covid-19, registration is limited to 30 participants.

Faced with the impossibility of foreseeing an outbreak of Covid-19 in the days prior to or close to the completion of the route that would cause the cancellation of the event, the return of the registration will be adjusted at the rate of the money recovered from the contracted hotels.

If the number of entries specified by the organization is exceeded, the rest will become part of the waiting list in strict order of registration until there is a vacancy.

The output of each stage will be of 1 minute intervals in order of arrival at the departure point in groups of at least 4 motorcycles.

This route does not have checkpoints, but has compulsory passage points that coincide with the mountain passes.

The time taken to complete each stage is calculated based on an average of 50 km per hour.

The itinerary will be provided to all the participants by email one week before the event to prepare it in advance, to gather the necessary documentation (GPS, maps, etc.). A map around the Pyrenees is recommended, as the GPS may be unreliable in some points of the route.

In case of abandonment of the route, participants must provide their personal assistance to ensure their return to their home with the assistance provided by the insurance of each vehicle.

RECOMMENDATION

Due to the height, location and topography of these ports through which the route is developed, there is the option that one of them can be closed. Therefore, the detailed study of the possible alternative route is recommended. It is very easy and can save time if you have studied the ground.

IMPORTANT

You can display the full path and get a complete and detailed road book through Google Maps copying and pasting the required points and mountain pass by the same numerical order.

To those who want, the organization will provide the route track for TomTom and Garmin navigators, must provide data cable.
